News from our parish school - Mrs. Betts, our headteacher, writes:

On Monday, Mrs Myatt and our GIFT team organised a prayerful day for us to reflect on our own Lenten journey and that of Jesus during the events of Holy Week. We began the day with a Whole School Mass in the church with Fr Joseph. There were lots of lovely comments about the children's singing.

Mass was followed by our Lent Day of Faith, where different activities planned by Mrs Myatt and the GIFT team were undertaken by the children, ably supported by several parishioners. Prayer spaces were set up around the hall, providing the children with opportunities to reflect on the events of Holy Week, asking 'big questions'; writing a prayer asking God to help those in power around the world to make choice for all; reflecting on our own crosses that we bear sometimes our problems and fears feel heavy; making links in our own daily lives — perhaps by turning over a new leaf and praying to God to ask for help just as Jesus did in the Garden of Gethsemane and saying sorry, knowing that we are forgiven through Jesus' death on the cross.

The children all made a mini Easter Garden, an Easter card and yummy Resurrection biscuits.t was a time for the whole school to stop and reflect on the events of Holy Week, participating in an interactive prayer space. The opportunity to sit quietly with their own thoughts is always valued by the children and as always, they engaged well with the prayers. Although the prayer spaces are primarily an opportunity for personal reflection, they also spark thoughtful conversation and support our children's mental health and spiritual development
